

Organics Odour Control System



Case Study Details

The Harvest Energy Garden in London, Ontario turns organic materials into clean, renewable energy and natural fertilizers. The site, formerly known as StormFisher Biogas converts discarded local organic materials into renewable electricity and organic and natural fertilizers for wholesale markets.

H2Flow provided a Biorem odour control system which removes odorous constituents from a process air stream. The odour control system included a biofilter system and an activated carbon system.

In addition, H2flow also provided a CON-V-AIR polymer feed system for digestate sludge. The polymer feed system system included bluk bag unloading system, screw feeder system and wetting cone and ejection system and a mixing tank.
